Dear Families,

What a ride this year has been. We began 2023 with the tragic news of the passing of Mrs. Stewart, and our first term continued with many disruptions and anxiety caused by COVID. We worked through hybrid learning models, online learning options and minimal visitor's onsite due to restrictions. We had numerous staff changes, farewelling Kay Elven and welcoming Mrs. B to our classrooms.

But despite the rocky start, our staff, students and community have been flexible, supportive and resilient.

There are so many highlights from throughout this year.

In term one, we held the first Nangadoo Combined Sports Day, which was a huge success. We travelled to Mt Gambier for weekly swimming lessons, enjoying a heated pool and being allowed on excursions again! We had Road Safety visits and travelled to Kalangadoo for World of Math's.

In term two, life seemed slightly more settled! Mackillop Award Growth in Learning This award is presented to the student from R-7 who consistently displays many powerful learning dispositions.


These include:
